Cancellations and Substitutions

If you wish to cancel a booking for the ALEP Lecture being held on Tuesday 12 March 2024 (the event), refunds on cancellations will be made as follows:

Received in writing by post or email by **Friday 23 February 2024** – 50% refund; Received after **Friday 23 February 2024** – no refund.

You may send an alternative delegate if you are unable to attend without incurring additional fees. However, you must inform ALEP of the alternative delegate's name by **Monday 26 February 2024**.
